Thank you for your entry in the CPE Agility trial on July 24th, 25th, and 26th, 2026 at Skowhegan State Fairgrounds in Skowhegan, ME.

 - You do not need to be registered with CPE to participate although your dog should have some experience on the equipment – for your safety and your dogs.

General Trial Information:

- **Snacks:** We will have prepackaged snacks available at this trial. The snacks are free to Volunteers and by donation for others.
- **Food:** We will not be ordering food at this trial. Please plan to bring your own lunches. There are many fast-food restaurants in the area, as well as a Grocery Store and Walmart.
- **Water:** EMAC will NOT provide bottled water at this trial. A water cooler with spring water will be provided so that you can fill your own water bottle, so BYOWB!

Important Trial Information:

- A previous email was sent containing information regarding your entry. **It is your responsibility to check this information carefully and notify the trial secretary of any errors as soon as possible.** Most errors cannot be fixed on the day of trial. - **MAPS** will be posted at 3:00 PM on www.mydogentry.com. I will also be emailing the maps each night, no later than 6:30 PM. Maps will also be posted near the ring.
- **Bait and toys:** These must be at least ten feet from the ring. Use the “bait baskets” provided just outside the gates to store your bait bags.
- All exhibitors **must** pick up after their dogs in all areas of the fairgrounds. Please use the trash cans for dog pick-up.
- **Fairgrounds:** If you are camping or staying in a tent, please pick up after your dog. If you wish to stay an extra night, please let the secretary know, and pay for the extra night.

Giving Opportunities

- **Swap Bin** – Do you have dog items you would like to get rid of? Bring them to our swap bin and see if someone else at the trial could use them!
- **Ribbon Regifting** – Do you have ribbons that you would like to regift to kids at Central Maine Schools? Kate Hill and Jan Niblock travel to schools and do demonstrations with their dogs.
