Thank you for entering DACLI's Scent Work Trial! We are grateful to be able to hold our Scent Work Trial at Doggie U, which allows us to offer the comfort of indoor crating. Please listen to any announcements during the day if we find it necessary to adjust things.

Search Sites: We will be using part of the front parking lot and the front areas of the building for the search areas. This will make the setup of the trial very different from other types of trials hosted at Doggie U. We will also be using the two "obedience" rings, crate room, front lobby and office. We may also be using the area behind the building for searches.

How to enter the building: Since the front areas of the building are being used for the searches, we are asking exhibitors to enter the building through the north alley way and enter through the back door. As a courtesy to the teams that are working, we are asking that you do not let the door slam.

Crating: Indoor crating will be available in the area in the back of the regular agility ring. For those of you who are new to Doggie U, this will be near the door you are using to enter the building. As there will be a few search areas inside the building, we are asking you to make sure your dogs are settled and are comfortable being in their crates. If your dog is reactive or gets stressed in the crate, we are asking that you consider working from your car. We will also have access to the back room for those dogs who are reactive.

Parking: Since we are using part of the front parking lot as a search area, we are not able to offer reserved parking for this trial. Parking will be next door in the Master Concepts parking lot and on the street.

Potty Areas: We are asking you to use the stone potty area in the front of Doggie U or to walk your dogs north of the facility. The grass strip in front of the building will not be available for this trial as it is part of the exterior search area. Please do not walk or potty your dogs on the business properties across the street. Wherever you do potty your dog, please pick up after him or her. Doggie U has poop bags in the mailbox in the potty area or inside the building if you should need them.

HOSPITALITY: The club will be providing hospitality drinks and snacks. It is recommended that you bring breakfast/lunch with you, since we will not be providing food for all exhibitors.

AWARDS: The Dog Agility Club of Long Island will be providing ribbons for qualifying scores and placements. Rosettes will also be provided for new class and all-around level titles. Results will be available at the end of each class.

We would like to thank you in advance for all of your cooperation in making DACLI's Scent Work Trial a success. As you can see, the trial committee has put a lot of thought into making the trial run smoothly and set it up so the teams that are working have the greatest chance for success. All of our trial committee members as well as our trial workers are all volunteers who have stepped up to make this trial happen. We would like to wish all you you the best of luck at the trial and we look forward to seeing you and your pups!

Directions:

From Southern State Pkwy, take exit 42 South, 5th Ave. Bay Shore. Stay to the left, make a left at the light onto 5th Ave, *turn left onto Spur Dr. North, (there is a McDonalds on the corner), take first right onto 5th Industrial Court. Doggie U is on the left, and you'll see a sign for "Master Concepts", which is in the same building. Spur Drive North is just slightly north of Southern State Parkway.

From Sunrise Hwy take exit 43 North, 5th Ave., then follow from *.

From the LIE, take exit 53, Sagtikos Pkwy, to Southern State Pkwy East, exit 42 North, then follow from *. (Alternate route for commercial or large vehicles, LIE exit 53 (same exit as Sagtikos Pkwy) to Wicks Rd. Travel for 3.8 miles south on Wicks Rd, which becomes 5th Ave, then right on Spur Dr. North, right onto 5th Industrial Court.)
