The overall SCHEDULE: Building opens 7:00, briefing 7:45, run 8:00 daily.

CRATING: Climate controlled Indoor Crating is allowed in designated areas. You must bring a tarp to put under your crate.

IMPORTANT NOTES: HANDLER DIFFERENT from owner must be reported to secretary.
(There's now a separate box on the entry form)

Reminder that Gamblers on Sunday is "**COMBINED**" – which means that all of you will be briefed on, walk and run the same one course, but it will still be scored by level.

MEASURING REQUIREMENTS have changed in UKI. I am working closely with UKI to comply with their requirements, as they suggest if you don't comply, you don't get to keep competing! I will have the new (green) Height Cards for dogs under 3 and I will work to measure any dogs. Be sure to see me if Derek measures your dog, since I have to keep the records and gather additional information like dog's date of

birth. I can also measure dogs not entered.

I show that only Gabrielle and Beatrice need measuring, but others can self-identify.

I take care of doing all the measurements as I am also a UKI Judge and keep all the records of dogs I've measured since October 2024.

If you're on this list, and were measured elsewhere, and the dog is less than 3, and you didn't get a height card, see me and I'll get you one.

The new rules mostly apply to younger dogs; if you look at your dog's information on the UKI website and it shows an asterisk * next to the dog's height then you don't have to do anything else. So, here's what UKI asks us to put in every final Confirmation: "Please ensure you understand the new criteria regarding dogs being measured. [UKI 11th Edition Rule Book.pdf](#)
If a dog is under 3 and newly registered, a temporary measure or proof of the dog's height must be done by the dog's 3rd trial. A permanent measure must be obtained by a UKI official measurer between 12-18 months after the dog's first/ temporary measure. Any registered dog that only has a temporary measure must follow the above rule. If a newly registered dog is over 3, they must obtain a measure by an official UKI measurer by their 3rd trial and this measurement will be permanent. If you ask for a challenge measure when you have a permanent measure, you must state this when you are getting the dog measured so the correct protocol can be followed and you may not continue to challenge a measure when you have challenged it once.

~"PM: Note that an AKC Permanent Height card now only counts as a temp measurement but still can be used.

Volunteers: Diane Harrington will be the volunteer coordinator. There is a large easel with worker grids. There will be a **worker raffle** including PMCC prizes – dollars off coupons for future trials.

Parking: Please Park where Premier staff has indicated. Absolutely no double parking is allowed in the front lot. All must park between the lines.

NEWER CHANGES TO COURSE MAPS DISTRIBUTION

Course Maps: -full-size course maps will be posted by the secretary's office.

-the package of course maps will be emailed each morning at 4

-the maps will be posted on MYDOGENTRY at 4 a.m. as well.

REASONS TO COME TO THE SECRETARY OFFICE IN THE MORNING:

-if this is your first PMCC Services trial, I have materials for you.

-if you owe money - those who do have been notified (you cannot pay UKI or MDE now!)

-If your dog shows as needing measuring. However, don't come to the office with your dog first thing in the morning, instead we will figure out a time to measure.

AT THE SITE: the Main Entrances to the Arena are doors on either side of the front of the building.

SPECIFIC CLASS BY CLASS RUNNING ORDER: The run order is attached in a separate file, and the final version will likely look a lot like this one. As always, we do our best to separate runs by people with multiple dogs in the class, even if it means more jump height changes. The trial has 150 or less runs per day as of this mailing, with more runs Sunday than Saturday.

VENDORS: I have no information on any vendors

Other things to know about the trial:

Absences: if for any reason you won't be attending, please text me at 732-547-0719

LEASH RUNNING note: in UKI you can't put it in your pocket, wrap it around your waist or wear it like a sash like at AKC. It has to be taken by leash runner to the place designated by the judge.

RESULTS/INFORMATION STICKERS – Will be put on a table near an outside door, in the main area in the southwest corner. Qualifying run / placement ribbons and New Title ribbons are provided by Premier Sports Center. I have limited quantities of championship ribbons (**IAC, IWAC, CSS, WCSS**) so we don't put them out, BUT IF you earn an IAC, IWAC, CSS or WCSS please let the Secretary know so you can be formally awarded a ribbon if available, we can take a quick picture with the judge. Results will be emailed as a PDF a day or two after the show for you to review, before they are sent on to UKI for posting.

MASTERS TOURNAMENT RESULTS

Will be available a short time after Masters Tournament concludes, money is readied, and certificates are printed. We will do the ceremony right before the Senior/Champ Speedstakes class runs, so please stay around.

Overnight Parking:

Camping/Overnight Parking must be prearranged. E-Mail Requests must be sent to Susan Bintliff – sabledogs@icloud.com Vehicles not in compliance with parking rules will be towed at the owner's expense.

FOOD – will not be available for purchase on site. Please Come prepared! There are Wawa stores on Route 70 and Route 206, each a few miles from the site.

Dog Exercise Areas:

Premier Sports Center has four acres of grass for you and your dogs to enjoy. All dogs need to be on leash while on Premier Sports Center property. The only exceptions for off leash are when at the practice jump or in the ring. Poop bags are to be discarded in outside trash receptacles only. Do not walk your dog on our business neighbor's properties. Pay attention to your dog and pick up after your dog. Anyone seen in person or on video not picking up after their dog or walking on the neighbor's property will be subject to a bench hearing and immediate excusal from the Center for the remaining day(s) of the trial. Do not let your male dog lift its leg on the building, front landscaping, or on any item a human needs to handle.

Please be considerate of the **public restrooms**. Trash cans will be placed in the bathrooms for proper disposal of paper products other than toilet paper. No dogs are allowed in public restrooms. Personal chairs/handicap chairs will not be allowed on the turf field. We will provide bench seating in the front of the rings for all to use. Please remove your personal belongings when your class has ended.

Smoking:

Is not permitted inside our facility and not encouraged outside near others. We prefer if you must smoke that it is done inside your vehicle and that your butts are discarded in your vehicle ashtray.

Sports Center Hours:

The Center will close, and doors will be locked approximately one hour after the last run has completed for the day. Be prepared.

Good Sportsmanship: Please treat others with kindness and respect. Please be ready to go into the ring when the judge specifies, and please leash up and get out of the ring as soon as possible.

1-TDC: is a sponsor of many UKI shows including the Invitational. PMCC is an authorized seller of 1-TDC/workssowell products and will have the 120-count capsules for dogs for just \$55. Hate to have to say it, but please pick up after your dog and place it in waste cans near the doors.
