- **Thursday Night Fun Runs:**
 - Fun Run signup will be at 3:30 pm and we will run from 4:00 pm – 6:00 pm providing we have enough set-up volunteers to have the ring ready.
 - Cost is \$5 per dog for EMAC members and \$10 for non-members. Payment is due when you sign up. Participants in the Fun Run are invited to volunteer to set bars and leash run to help speed things along.
 - You do not need to be registered with CPE to participate although your dog should have some experience on the equipment – for your safety and your dogs.

General Trial Information:

- **Snacks:** We will have prepackaged snacks available at this trial. The snacks are free to Volunteers and for purchase by others.
- **Lunch:** We will not be ordering lunch at this trial. Please plan to bring your own lunch.
- **Water:** In an effort to “go green” and use less plastic, EMAC will NOT provide bottled water at this trial. A water cooler will be provided - you can fill your own water bottle, so BYOWB!

- **Friday Carnival Game:** Pick rubber duckies from a pool – the highest score wins!
- **Saturday Carnival Game:** Ring Toss for prizes!

Important Trial Information:

- A previous email containing your entry information has already been sent. **It is your responsibility to check this information carefully and notify the trial secretary of any errors as soon as possible.** Most errors cannot be changed on the day of trial. Please email me at emactrials@gmail.com if you need something corrected.
- **MAPS** will be posted at 3:00 PM on www.mydogentry.com. I will also be emailing the maps each night, no later than 6:30 PM. Maps will also be posted near the ring.
- **Bait and toys:** These must be at least ten feet from the ring. Use the “bait baskets” provided just outside the gates to store your bait bags.
- All exhibitors **must** pick up after their dogs in all areas of the campground. Please use the trash cans for dog pick up.
- **Campground:** If you are camping or staying in a cabin at Hadley's Point Campground, please make sure you check with the staff for the time you need to be off the campsite, or out of the cabin. The campground does have required check-out times. Remember, they have other guests coming in on Sunday :)
