Please be advised that FRAAD will comply with all state, county and facility COVID regulations that exist at the time of the trials.

Please be respectful of your fellow exhibitors. If you or your dog is coughing or has recently been exposed to a contagious disease such as COVID or kennel cough, please do not share it at the trial.

New World Screwworm

Please read if you do interstate travel; especially to/from TX & NM:

In early June 2026, cases of New World Screwworm (NWS) have been detected in southwest Texas and New Mexico. The American Kennel Club (AKC) recommends that all dog owners, or anyone who works with dogs, to learn about NWS and to stay updated on developments.

Colorado adopted an Emergency Rule on June 10, 2026 outlining requirements for animals entering Colorado from an NWS infested state, saying all dogs and cats entering from states with an Active NWS Infested Zones must have a CVI (health certificate) within 5 days prior to entry into Colorado. SETUP & CRATING

We would love your help. Ring setup will be on Friday morning at 6:30 am. Those volunteering for ring setup will be able setup crates and dogs when you arrive, and then you can help out with trial and ring setup. Please follow the volunteer link provided below to sign up for set up.

Place clean, waterproof tarps under all mats, crates and EX-pens. The use of ex-pens is restricted to the size that one crate per dog would take. If your dog is reactive, please be considerate in choosing your crating location. We will ask you to move dogs who are lunging or otherwise aggressive. The show committee reserves the right to alter crating arrangements for space purposes.

TRIAL RUNNING ORDER

ATTENTION: Randomized Jump Height Order

This trial has a RANDOMIZED JUMP HEIGHT ORDER. Per Section 8 of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials, p. 85, AKC encourages that run orders are randomized by class. This includes jump height orders as well as order of competitors within a jump height.

Pay close attention to the Judging Schedule (below) and the published Running Order Catalog.

This letter includes the order of classes and heights listed below. The Running Order will be sent to exhibitors in a separate link with final confirmations and are found at MyDogEntry: <https://tinyurl.com/FRAAD-ISC-agility> and on groups.io at <https://groups.io/g/ColoradoAgility/files>.

FOOD & VENDORS

There will be no food available on site, but there are a number of local restaurants a few miles away.

COMMON COURTESIES AND POTTY AREAS

Please be nice to the Facility Personnel and Volunteer Workers. Remember to thank them and wish them a happy day.

The use of these facilities is a privilege; PLEASE follow the rules of the club and the facility. Leash laws are enforced; all dogs must be on lead or confined to crates or x-pens when not being judged, except when in the designated warm-up area.

Please clean up after your dogs. Walk your dog beyond the marker signs at each exit and **stay off of mulched landscaped zones near the building. We can no longer use the grass area on the School Bus Property as a potty area.** Do not let your dog urinate on buildings or anything that a human may touch, and place poop in the proper trash can. Please clean up accidents IMMEDIATELY. Anyone observed not cleaning up after their dog, or allowing their dog run off-lead, will be asked to leave the trial site for the remainder of the weekend without refund. Please remember these courtesies should be extended to the hotels as well. Your thoughtfulness in this matter is appreciated.

AKC MEASUREMENTS AND CHECK-IN

Armbands will not be used at this trial. If your dog needs to be measured, the judge will measure your dog to ensure you are entered the correct height. If the judge measures a dog into a height other than what you entered, the entry may be changed from Regular to Preferred or from Preferred to Regular, as long as the dog has not run any classes that day.

CONFLICTS AND LIVE GATING RUN ORDER

We are using a randomized jump height order per Section 8 of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials.

We are using MyDogEntry (MDE) Live Gating Program, and there will be no paper gate boards. There will be a Monitor and iPad at the gate. Check your dogs in for each class, or mark them as FEO, Absent or Conflict, using the MDE website or app. See instructions below.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. Be at the gate at least 3 dogs before your turn.

Conflicts: Since we have a one judge trial, there shouldn't be many conflicts. PLEASE plan ahead! Walking and running with an earlier height group allows the score table to close out classes and post results and ribbons in a timely manner.

If you do have a conflict with your run time that can't be accommodated by moving within your height, you must walk/run in an earlier jump height. If your conflict is only with your walkthrough, walk with an earlier group so the score table may close out classes. You may only move your dog in the order IF you have a legitimate conflict with the other ring or working the trial. Separating multiple dogs is allowed only if you keep them in the original order and, if possible, move the first dog up in the order. Any other reason for moving a dog MUST have the permission of the Judge!

COURSE MAPS, RESULTS, RIBBONS, & DOCUMENTS

The Trial Schedule, Running Order of dogs, and Course Maps, will be found at MyDogEntry: <https://tinyurl.com/FRAAD-ISC-agility>.

MAPS – Course maps will be posted online on MyDogEntry each morning prior to the start of judging. Please access the course maps from the web site. One paper copy will be posted on site so you may take photos to have on your mobile device.

RESULTS - Results will be displayed as quickly as possible in a designated area as each height/class concludes, and displayed on MyDogEntry when possible. Carbon copies will not be available.

RIBBONS - Ribbons will be available and will be self-service.

MOVE-UPS & WAITLIST

There are no move-ups for this one-day ISC trial. At closing, there were no wait-lists for any day.

BITCHES IN SEASON (BIS)

1. Eligibility:
 - Bitches in season are permitted to compete at AKC ISC-only trials at clubs' discretion.
 - BIS will be allowed to compete at this trial
2. Prohibited Equipment:
 - BIS are required to wear panties, except when in the ring
 - BIS may not run in panties, pants, or diapers at any time on course.
3. Club Policies:
 - Notify Trial Secretary of BIS so run orders can be changed.
 - BIS will be moved to the end of each class
 - The club will provide a mat for BIS at the start-line
 - Panties must be left at the start-line
 - Separate crating and potty areas will be designated for BIS

PARKING REGULATIONS

Exhibitors are governed by any rules or regulations of civil authorities and building and parking regulations. Vehicles parked contrary to regulations will be subject to towing at owner's expense. Parking in handicapped spaces is limited to those with handicapped permits. Please maximize parking spaces as much as possible by parking close to the car next to you and do not block other cars in.

Club officials may require that vehicles or equipment be rearranged to accommodate additional vehicles. Please keep area around vehicles clean at all times. All vehicles will be parked at owner's risk. FRAAD will not be responsible for loss by burglary, fire, or any other cause whatsoever to the vehicle or its contents.

RV PARKING

RV Parking is by Pre-Paid reservation only! Limited dry camping spaces are available and generator diverters are required. TRIAL JUDGING SCHEDULE

Rings will alternate.

Jump height orders as well as order of competitors within a jump height are randomized by class.

Classes will be judged in the following order. Walkthroughs preceded the run time.

The trial committee and judges reserve the right to re-organize the schedule to accommodate the needs of the trial.
Breaks may be called at the judge's or trial committee's discretion.

Located at the southeast corner of Kipling and Hampden. From the intersection of HWY285/Hampden and Kipling, go south. Take the first left on W. Hampden Ave. at the light (not the Frontage Road). You will see a Mini-Golf facility on the corner. The road winds to the right up to the facility on the hill. Building has a "Foothills Sports Arena" sign.

Using the MDE website, you will be able to check your dogs in for each class, or mark them as FEO, Absent, or Conflict. The Judging Schedule, Running Order, and Maps will be posted to MDE.

First time using MyDogEntry? Go to <https://mydogentry.com/> on your phone or smart device. The site has a blue background and a happy-looking white/brown dog. We have club members available to help you use the site – please ask at the score table and we will find someone to work with you.

If you have a conflict or need to separate your dogs in the running order, please work with the Gate Steward, or other knowledgeable club member, to move your dog. Please see the CONFLICTS section above for guidelines on when you may move your dog.

As the class is running, you can monitor class progress on the site, but please keep an eye on the ring to make sure you get there in time.

Instructions

All of the following can be done using your home computer, tablet, or mobile phone.

Each morning of this trial there will be a large "Check-In" button at the top of the MyDogEntry screen.



- If you are logged in to your MyDogEntry account when you click "Check-In", you'll see a list of your dogs and can check-in for each class.
- If you are not logged in to your MyDogEntry account when you click "Check-In", you'll see a list of trial locations. Click on your trial location and you'll see a list of all dogs. Scroll down to find your dog's name. Click on your dog and check-in for each class.
- Update the button next to your dog to one of these choices:
 - White: Not checked in
 - Green: Checked-In
 - Yellow/Orange: Conflict
 - Red: Scratched/Absent

Each morning of this trial there will also be a large "Run Order" button at the top of the MyDogEntry screen.

- If you are logged in to your MyDogEntry account when you click "Run Order", you'll see the current run order and your dog will be highlighted in green.
- If you are not logged in to your MyDogEntry account when you click "Run Order", you'll see a list of trial locations. Click on your trial location to see the current run order.
- The dog shown at the top of the screen is either currently running or will run next.
- The estimated run times will update automatically throughout the day.
