WAIT LIST

After the closing date of August 26, 2026, FRAAD is offering a wait list to fill openings created by entries withdrawn after closing, only if the trial exceeds entry limits as stated above. A maximum of 25 entries will be placed on the wait list. All entries, including wait-listed entries, must be received by the trial secretary prior to closing. Any entries withdrawn prior to Monday, September 7, 2026, 5:00 PM will be replaced by a wait listed entry when available. A full refund will be given for withdrawn entries when a wait-listed entry is available to replace the withdrawn entry. Any wait-listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by Monday, September 7, will receive a full refund.

CHANGE OF ENTRY

Chapter 1. Section 21. In addition to Move-ups as described in Chapter 1, Section 20 entries may also be changed after closing as noted in this section. 1) A dog which has been entered in a Novice "A" class for which it is not eligible to be entered in due to class restrictions on the dog or handler may be moved to the Novice "B". 2) If a handler entered the dog in a higher class than eligible, the dog may be moved to the class for which the dog is eligible (i.e. Master to Excellent). The request for the move must be in writing and presented to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial. The request must state the reason and justification for the move.

CATERING

There will be no onsite concessions or Hospitality at this trial. Please be prepared and bring your own.

COURSE FAMILIARIZATION and WARMUPS

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A walk-through period will be held prior to each class, following the Judge's Briefing. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class.

Course maps will be posted to Agility Gate each morning and hard copies will be posted at the trial site.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors.

Awards for qualifying scores only. All awards must be claimed at the show. Ribbons will be awarded to first through fourth place in each height division in each class.
First Place: Rose Ribbon ~ Second Place: Brown Ribbon ~ Third Place: Lt. Green Ribbon
Fourth Place: Gray Ribbon ~ Qualifying Score: Dark Green Ribbon

All prizes must be claimed the day of the trial. None will be mailed.

Non-Regular Agility Classes International Sweepstakes Class (ISC)

Chapter 14

Section 1. Purpose. The International Sweepstake Class (ISC) is a non-regular class providing a dog and handler an opportunity to demonstrate their advanced training and handling skills on various international style Standard and Jumpers With Weaves courses. The rules for this class are generally based on Fédération Cynologique International (FCI) rules. ISC Course design should reflect current FCI design.

Section 2. Eligibility of Dogs. This class is open to dogs that are eligible to compete in AKC Agility Trials. Dogs may be entered in any of the offered class levels and in multiple levels at the trial.

Section 3. Class Levels. Clubs may offer any combination of classes listed below per trial:

ISC Agility 1
ISC Agility 2
ISC Agility 3
ISC Jumping 1
ISC Jumping 2
ISC Jumping 3

****Please note: You may jump your regular or preferred AKC jump height or jump the FCI heights listed below. ****

Section 8. Jump Heights. All AKC heights will be offered, except for 24C. Dogs may be entered in their regular AKC jump heights or may choose to run in their FCI height category. At ISC only trials dogs may be entered as FEO as described in Chapter 5, Section 7. Dogs may be entered in their Preferred height category and will be scored with dogs running in the corresponding Regular height. It is highly encouraged that run orders are randomized by class. This includes jump height orders as well as order of competitors within a jump height.

FCI Height Category	Height at Withers	ISC Jump Heights
Small	Dogs measuring 13-3/4" and less	12"
Medium	Dogs measuring 16-7/8" and less	16"
Intermediate	Dogs measuring 18- 7/8" and less	20"
Large	Dogs measuring greater than 18-7/8"	24"

Bitches in Season (BIS)

1. Eligibility:
 - Bitches in season are permitted to compete at AKC ISC-only trials at clubs' discretion.
 - BIS will be allowed to compete at this trial
2. Prohibited Equipment:
 - BIS are required to wear panties, except when in the ring
 - BIS may not run in panties, pants, or diapers at any time on course.
3. Club Policies:
 - Notify Trial Secretary of BIS so run orders can be changed.
 - BIS will be moved to the end of each class
 - The club will provide a mat for BIS at the start-line
 - Panties must be left at the start-line
 - Separate crating and potty areas will be designated for BIS

***** **TWO WAYS TO ENTER** *****

- 1) Send a completed entry form and entry fee check with any vouchers via a postal carrier to Suzy Hiskey, 8073 W. Polk Pl. Littleton, CO 80123.
- 2) Enter online via LABTESTEDONLINE.COM. This is similar to the defunct AKC Online entry system and requires an account with LabTested, but it works great! LabTested can also be used to save yours and your dog's info to create and print entry forms for normal postal delivery.

During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as 140 runs online (40%), 210 runs paper (60%) each day. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48-hour period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either one accordingly.

If you entered online and have FRAAD AKC Vouchers, please follow the below rules for voucher redemption:

1. Complete the **Voucher Redemption Form** (form is below or will be available at the score table)
2. Bring your FRAAD AKC vouchers and completed voucher redemption form to the trial and submit them to a worker at the score table (don't just leave them at the table)
3. A refund of your voucher amount will be sent to you via Zelle at the conclusion of the trial (please wait up to 1 week from the conclusion of the trial to receive your refund)

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

As of January 1, 2021, For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO allows exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring. Toys must be non-audible and may not leave the handler's hand. Toys that roll freely may not be used.
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

Fix and Go On (FNG)

Fix and Go On allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using Fix and Go On will result in a non-qualifying score. Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the run and does not need to be signaled by the exhibitor.

REGULAR AKC JUMP HEIGHTS & MEASUREMENTS

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. Dogs in Preferred classes **MUST** jump their measured height.

If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured PRIOR to running. Please mark the appropriate box on the entry form that specifies whether your dog has a Permanent (over 2 yrs)/Temporary height card/form (under 2 yrs) or needs to be measured. All Owners are responsible for marking the appropriate box.

Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured by the Judge of Record PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. However, if an Agility Field Representative or a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) is present, ALL dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog measured by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog before its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured PRIOR to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

If a dog is measured by an AKC Rep. or VMO and is now eligible to jump in a lower height class, the measurement is effective immediately for any future runs. This does not apply to a challenge measurement for a permanent jump height card, which become effective when the challenge measurement process is complete.

If a AKC Rep. or VMO measures a dog into a height other than what they entered, the entry may be changed from Regular to Preferred or from Preferred to Regular, if the dog has not run any classes that day. If the dog has already run, the change may be made for the next trial day(s). The exhibitor must provide the Trial Secretary the AKC Agility Measurement Form when requesting the class change.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

This trial will be conducted in accordance with the Rules for Agility Trials. Dogs qualifying at this titling event, receive credit toward their title. A recording fee is included with entry fees. Fees must accompany entries.

ELIGIBILITY: This trial is open to all dogs 15 months of age or older that are registered with the AKC, or have a limited registration, or are of a registerable breed that have obtained a PAL, or ILP number from AKC, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are eligible to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Puppies under four months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

ENTRIES AND REFUNDS: Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on their signed entry forms. Entries are taken on a first received basis. A returned check will invalidate an entry and a \$30.00 service fee will be charged regardless of circumstances. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis for all FRAAD events. Telephoned, Faxed, or unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC entry forms and photocopies of entry forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are not acceptable. No entry shall be made, and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions to its acceptance. Entries sent via express mail service, must be indicated "NO SIGNATURE REQUIRED."

Entries cannot be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted after the entries have closed except as provided for in chapter 14, section 6 of the Dog Show Rules. Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or email prior to the close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable. There is no refund for duplicate entries. We will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if the entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, and barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. Overpayment of entries \$5 and under will not be refunded. Withdrawals due to injury or illness of dog after the closing dates are eligible for a 50% voucher for future entry, provided a veterinarian's letter is provided within one week of the trial. In such instances the secretary **MUST** be notified by letter or e-mail, no later than Thursday, September 11, 2025 at 8:00 am. False reports warrant refusal of entries at future FRAAD trials. Any other withdrawals after the closing date will not be eligible for refund. No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, violent acts of nature, extreme weather, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR, LIABILITY: FRAAD may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other cause, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against FRAAD or any official thereof. Front Range Agility Association of Denver (FRAAD), their agents, employees, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or their dogs, or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to guests and/or children. Please, no baby strollers on the trial grounds.

Safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and are able to perform all of the obstacles safely. All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or the designated warm-up area. It is expressly understood that the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s), guest(s), and children. Any exhibitor whose dog(s), guest(s), and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of fees paid will be made.

All regulations governing the use of this facility, and all regulations and decisions of the trial committee at this trial will be strictly enforced, including and not limited to the recorded information of this premium list.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. They will adhere as closely as possible to the judging schedule. The owners or handlers of each dog are solely responsible for being ready at ringside when the class is to be judged. The trial giving club and the Trial Secretary have no obligation or responsibility for providing service runners or public address system for the purposes of locating or calling dogs that are not brought to the ringside when required.

This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the official AKC entry form for this event.

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **A gility J ump H eight C ard** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or **back-to-back trials** only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine Partners Program**SM may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.
