TRIAL SITE RULES:

ENTER VIA PENNY LANE, NOT Tetz Lane.

Skyline's landlord now requires all trial traffic to enter and exit the property via Penny Lane. If you are coming from the south on Scotchtown Ave, Penny Lane is on the right approx. 500 feet before Tetz Lane. If you are coming from the north, Penny Lane will be on the left about 500 feet after Tetz Lane. We are hopeful that signs for Penny Lane will be installed prior to the trial.

All dogs must be on leash at all times, except when in the ring. Exercise and toilet your dog in designated areas. Please poop and scoop and use garbage containers on the site. Please be courteous to others using the area. No aggressive dogs.

- **5 mph speed limit on the property.** Violators can be subject to a trial committee hearing.
- Park only in designated areas as directed by trial officials. Do not block RVs!
- Please stay close to the barn! The fields, areas by the houses, the horse paddock area, and fenced runs in front of the building are all off limits.
- Crating is not permitted in the seating area of the arena. Guest crating available in some stalls. It is convenient to work from your car, and there is plenty of room to tent/crate outside in the designated areas.
- During trial hours, dogs must be on leash at all times when not competing in the arena or at the practice jump. No flexi leashes in extension allowed in the barn or arena.
- No food or treats are to be left in the stalls or the arena overnight.
- No personal heaters of any kind - propane, kerosene or electric - are allowed in stalls, in any building or within 100 feet of any building.
- No smoking in any building or within 50 feet of any building. Cigarette butts must be properly disposed of.
- All trash is to be placed in proper receptacles, black/garbage and blue/ recycling

- Clean up after your dog. The orange poop cans with bags are located outside.

Location: Ramapo Search and Rescue, 120 Tetz Lane, Middletown, New York. Convenient to the NY Thruway, I-84, and NY-17.

From the NYS Thruway (North or South): Exit 16 - Merge onto NY-17 W Take exit 122 - Crystal Run Crossing. Turn right onto Crystal Run Crossing. Turn left onto Crystal Run Road. Take to end - make right at stop sign - County Rd 83/ Goshen Turnpike/ Scotchtown Ave. Approximately 1 mile to PENNY LANE - . Left onto Penny Lane to end. From the West: I-84 Eastbound – Take Exit 19A for NY-17 E towards New York City. Keep Right for County Rd 67/Crystal Run Rd. At traffic light, turn Left onto Crystal Run Rd, follow for 2 miles, turn Right at Stop Sign onto Goshen Turnpike/Scotchtown Ave. After 1 mile, turn Left onto PENNY LANE . Follow to end. From the East: I-84 Westbound – Take Exit 19A to merge onto NY-17 towards New York City. Take Exit 122 for County Rd 67/Crystal Run Rd. At traffic light, turn Left onto Crystal Run Rd, follow for 2 miles, turn Right at Stop Sign onto Goshen Turnpike/Scotchtown Ave. After 1 mile, turn Left onto PENNY LANE Follow to end.

Bitches in Season -

May run at this trial. To be able to run a BIS, you must immediately tell the trial secretary who will mark BIS on the running orders. The BIS will remain in their running order. If the dog is not wearing BIS pants, they will start on a mat provided by the show. It is the handler's responsibility to ensure the mat is available for their runs. The handler/owner acknowledges the inherent risk of running a dog on an agility course with BIS pants on and assumes all risk by doing so, and the potential risks with slips from starting from a mat. NOTE: the trial can choose to run the BIS at the end of the class: please swap to state: Any BIS will run at the end of the class, regardless of height.

A LATE entry is any entry received after online closing and is subject to a surcharge. For this trial, regular runs will be \$19. Late Masters Series entries are \$40. Get your entries in early and save!

Results will be posted outside the ring on by the ribbons table and may include information labels and Q stickers. A full summary of runs is sent in the days following the trial for your review prior to their being sent to UKI. FMI pmccservices@gmail.com

GAMBLERS is an international game where in the first timed period, you make your own course to accumulate points. In the second part of the game, you do one of two sequences to earn Gamble Points. At all levels other than Beginner, you need games level points in order to title and move up to the next level. The game will be run "combined" meaning that everyone walks and runs the same course but is scored separately. The game will be explained by the judge.

A handler who wins either class and competes in the other class earns a Qualify for Masters Final at the next U.S. Open. Also, teams that finish first or second overall qualify for the Masters Finals. First and sometimes second place finishers also win prize money. A certificate will be awarded at a short ceremony after Masters Series concludes and prize money will be distributed as well, see page 11.

By entering this event, you, as the entrant, acknowledge that you are authorized to act on behalf of both yourself and any other UK Agility International (UKI) members who will participate under your entry and you agree to the following:

1. Assumption of Risk & Liability

The exhibitor/owner certifies that any and all dogs brought to the facility, whether participating or not, do not pose a hazard to persons, dogs, or property. The exhibitor/owner assumes full responsibility, liability, any resulting expenses for any damages caused by their dog(s).

UK Agility International (UKI), UK Agility Ltd, their agents, officers, associates and members shall not be held liable for any loss, injury, damage, claims, demands, or liabilities involving your dog, yourself, or any third-party equipment. You agree to indemnify and hold harmless UKI and its representatives (including the club/group/ trial organizers, show management) from any claims, including legal fees, arising from injury or damages caused during participation in any event or training.

2. Hazards & Safety

The exhibitor/owner acknowledges all potential hazards associated with the training facility, event, and premises, including but not limited to: The condition of the grounds; Lighting and security measures (or lack thereof); Electrical appliances and fittings; Parking areas and fencing; The potential for a dog to escape from the training or competition area; The presence of unfamiliar animals and people; The presence of other dogs; Agility equipment; Course design and course set up; The possibility of another ill animal or your own getting ill. The exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from and all of these including allowing their dogs to run wearing collars, stop pad protectors, bitch in season pants, or any similar items.

By entering, you voluntarily assume any and all risks associated with these hazards and any other potential hazards not listed. All participants must exercise caution, monitor their dogs, and clean up after themselves and their animals.

3. Conduct & Enforcement

UK Agility International reserves the right to:

- **Excuse any participant** for what it deems excessive harshness toward a dog and for behavior considered aggressive or abusive toward another person or dog.
- **Revoke, suspend, or ban** any entry or membership at its sole discretion if deemed necessary to protect the interests of UK Agility and any of its associates, agents, officers, or members.

Participation in UKI events, including membership, is a **privilege, not a right**. UK Agility International has full authority to impose suspensions or bans without prior notice.

4. Rules & Regulations

Measuring Dogs

Please ensure you understand the criteria regarding dogs being measured. Refer to the current edition rule book which can be found on the UKI web page. [UKI 11th Edition Rule Book.pdf](#) A summary of the rules can also be found here [Jump Heights | UK Agility International](#)

If a dog is under 3 and newly registered, a temporary measure or proof of the dog's height must be done by the dog's 3rd trial. A permanent measure must be obtained by a UKI official measurer between 12-18 months after the dog's first/ temporary measure. Any registered dog that only has a temporary measure, must follow the above rule. If a newly registered dog is over 3, they must obtain a measure by an official UKI measurer by their 3rd trial and this measurement will be permanent.

Level Move-ups Exhibitors are responsible for tracking their dog's points in each of the two UKI programs and must move their dog to the next eligible level on the following day of a multiple-day trial once sufficient points have been earned. Competitors must notify the trial secretary on the day their dog gains enough points to move up in a particular program. Exhibitors may log into their UKI account to confirm and tally points. Please consult the UKI rule book for detailed information on level requirements.

BY ENTERING UKI EVENTS, COMPETITORS AGREE TO the following and the terms and conditions on the entry forms

UK Agility International Rules and Regulations apply to the whole event, and all people and dogs must comply with these at all times. As a competitor it is your responsibility to be aware of the rules and regulations as they stand at the time of the show. This show will run under the current edition UK Agility International rules found on the UKI web page.

Competitors through submission of entry acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of UK Agility International rules and regulations including but not limited to the following rules regarding entry

Please ensure to read the move up rules – section 2.0. At a UKI trial where the dog is competing for more than one day and the dog completes the requirements for a level on a prior day; they must move up the following day.

All dogs and handlers must be registered with UK Agility International to compete. UK Agility International's official rules & regulations are available to view free from the UKI web page. If you or your dog is not already registered, please register online at www.ukagilityinternational.com

All dogs are entered at this show at their owners' risk; and neither the show nor event management nor UKI will accept responsibility for any loss, damage or injury, however caused or claimed to have been caused by or to dogs, persons or property while at the UKI event.

A dog shall be withdrawn from competition without refund if it is: suffering from any infectious or contagious disease, interfering with the safety of any person or other animal or if it is likely to cause itself damage or its welfare is in danger if it continues competing. It is expressly understood that competitors are solely responsible for the behavior of their dogs, children and guests. Any competitor whose dogs, children, or guests create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, will at the discretion of the show management, be asked to remove the offending dogs, children, guests from the event grounds. Any competitor or competitor's dog that is dismissed from the show by the judge and or show manager in accordance with UKI rules and regulations will have no recourse of any kind including, but not limited, to any refund of fees paid such as entry fees, camping fees, crating fees and any other fees associated with the event.

Rules of Conduct

UKI promotes dog agility pursuant to regulations consistent with international standards as a competitive, spectator sport. All competitors, officials, and event personnel shall conduct themselves in a professional and sportsmanlike manner consistent with the foregoing statement of purpose and seek to uphold, and enhance where possible, the image of the sport and UKI through such conduct and actions including on social media platforms.

By virtue of your entry, competitors acknowledge and agree to comply with all UKI rules and regulations and agree to accept any sanctions that are imposed for failure to comply. The judge has responsibility for determining when it is appropriate to excuse a dog and competitor from the ring. The show officials have responsibility for determining when an infraction should result in a verbal warning, written warning and/or expulsion of a competitor, dog, or any person from the event by conducting the procedure outlined in the UKI rule book. UKI officials, after further investigation, may impose sanctions including suspension or expulsion from future events.

The following is a partial list of infractions on which the judge or trial officials will take action: Abuse of a dog on the grounds; actions that may have the appearance of abuse of a dog; willful misconduct or interference with a competitor's right to show; any acts of poor sportsmanship; violation of procedural rules; compulsive, correctional training on the grounds; willful misrepresentation on entry forms; willful misrepresentation of animals; dog aggression; failure to exercise diligence in the control of the behavior of their dog including a dog clearly not under the control of the handler; concerns for the welfare of a dog or who is unfit for competing; intimidation and/or impolite confrontation of judges, event officials, event helpers, or other competitors; creating excessive delays as a failure to respect the authority of event officials.

Social Media Conduct

Cyber bullying of any kind towards UKI, trial management & staff, competitors, judges, helpers or volunteers will not be tolerated. Examples of cyber bullying include but are not limited to, communications that seek to intimidate, manipulate, falsely discredit, put down, try to control, rudely confront, demand, and comments that try to incite further issues. Further, UKI is committed to maintaining an environment that is built on mutual respect and is free from racism, discrimination and harassment. In keeping with this goal, any

behavior that is hateful towards race, color, religion, creed, national origin or ancestry, ethnicity, sex, and gender will not be tolerated. Any of these cases may warrant removal from all associated social media pages and even lead to expulsion of UKI events and even further expulsion of organization membership.

Refund and Entry Cancellation Policy

Entries may be accepted, changed, or altered after the closing date unless the capping level has been reached except for the purpose of moving to a higher level. A full UKI membership refund is available for any membership that is not older than 14 days from the date of account creation. A full refund of your entry is available before the closing date or capping level is met for any show. After the closing date, a partial entry adjustment may be available for extraordinary circumstances, but this lies with the individual show management based on their own policies. Payment of Entry fees

Payment of online entry fees) must be made directly to the PMCC Services account and paid to the Trial Secretary before a competitor may compete. Only you are responsible to cancel your entry online by going back into the mydogentry show you entered and clicking CANCEL MY ENTIRE ENTRY. Ask PMCC For help if needed. If in doubt, you must check your entries from mydogentry entries link as well as reviewing your account transactions. If you have not cancelled your entry as above before the closing date, you are still responsible to pay the entry fee.

Additional administration charges may be imposed to a member's account due to negligence that result in administration time to correct. Possible infractions, not limited to, are submitting incorrect trial entry information, including incorrect handler and dog number, creating duplicate membership or dog accounts and late payment fees.

Masters Series Tournament Rules

The aim of the Masters Series is to encourage more competitive running in UKI classes and improve the overall standard of top-level agility. The Masters has been created for dogs and competitors whose goal is to compete at both National and International level.

General Rules

Open to all UKI level dogs including Select heights. Separate competition for each height. Agility and Jumping rounds with results combined. Handlers must run in strict running orders, failure to do so will result in elimination. Either Agility or Jumping classes may run first. If a handler has 2 dogs entered within a jump height, they may move their first dog up so that there are as many dogs as possible between their dogs. If this is not possible, they will receive a 6-minute break. If a handler has more than 2 dogs within a jump height and the entry is not large enough for a sufficient gap in between all their dogs, the first of their dogs drawn will be allowed to run in between

a jump height change, if a jump height change is available before their height. If it is not, the final decision will be made by the judge and show manager, taking into consideration fairness to the competitor and other entrants in the Masters Class. Day of Entries must run first within the running orders of the first class. The second class must run in reverse order of placing from first class. The dog must run in the height that he will compete at in the Masters Final. The same dog and handler must run both rounds. Only the handler who qualifies the dog through a Masters Heat, may run the dog in the Masters Final. Any extraordinary circumstances to be ruled by UKI.

Scoring

Standard UK Agility Marking will apply. Faults converted into seconds. 5 faults = 5 seconds. Time faults treated the same as course faults. An elimination = 100 faults plus 60 second course time. An absent or NFC run = 1000 faults with a 60 second course time. Dogs with an absent or NFC run in either the Agility or Jumping will forfeit any Q's or awards gained in the other round; in other words, both rounds must be run for competition. Dogs with double elimination will not be placed. An E in the individual round will not be placed in that round. Dogs with the lowest score will be deemed the winner. In the event of a tie, the Agility result will be the deciding factor, followed by the jumping result. If a tie still remains, a runoff will be required. If there is a tie for the Individual class wins, a runoff will be required on that course to determine the winner and subsequent placings.

Final Qualification 2 ways to qualify for the Final to be held at the UKI US Open:

A. Individual Winners (per height) of the Masters Agility or Masters Jumping class (even if an E is earned in the other round).	B. 1st & 2nd Overall (per height) (even if an E is earned in one of the rounds).
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Prizes

Of the Prize entry fee; \$5.00 is placed in heat prize fund. Each height has its own prize fund and will be divided as per Masters "Prize Money Guide". Prize fund is for overall winners only. \$1 from each entry fee will be evenly split & placed in the Final prize fund and Team USA WAO fund. In the event there is not a monetary winner within a height, the prize money will be sent to UKI to go towards the Final prize fund.
