CPE will hold 15 entries for Host Club and CPE Representatives

Unlike other years that had limits that did not fill, no pending entries will be accepted nor will the closing dates be extended, regardless of the number of entries.

Entry Information

Entry Method – Random Draw with an Opening Date:

Entry mail in or online entry period: May 15, 2026, 12pm Central Time (CST)–May 29, 2026

- Entries may be received at any time on or after the opening date and time.
- Entries received before the opening date will be destroyed.
- **Note:** Overnight envelopes must have the recipient's signature waiver signed or the envelope may be refused or delayed.

If CSS does not fill: Entries will be accepted until July 3, 2026, 6pm Central Time (CST)

- Between July 3 – August 3 (closing date), 2026, no entries will be accepted
- During this time, only the following changes will be allowable
 - Adding or removing a Jr Handler or Handicapped Handler
- Do not send level changes until the move up/down dates below

Final Closing Date – Note the early Closing Date will be August 3, 2026, 6pm Central Time (CST)

- Checks deposited as early as July 3, 2026. CSS online entry fees will be charged when your entry is accepted from the trial not filling, or from the random draw if needed – by entering, you state that you accept being entered in CSS for the 2026 CPE Nationals and that your entry fees will be deposited or charged per the information in this premium regarding entry acceptance and/or random draw entry acceptance without additional notification prior to the first confirmations being emailed.
- There will NO REFUNDS of Entries withdrawn after August 3, 2026

Entry Mailing

- Emails regarding status of entry will not be answered if received before June 15, 2026.
- If you wish to have delivery verification for your entry, be sure to use e-confirmation with the post office and waive any signature requirements or the delivery of your entry will be delayed. Do not send by certified mail!
- Receipt of delivery will not be verified before first confirmations are sent.
- Limit of entries per envelope: six (6) Dogs per event, if entered in multiple events, they can be included in one envelope with up to 6 dogs total amongst the entries. Note: The exception will be no limit if all dogs in the same envelope have the same 5 digit CPE membership number.

An entry will not be accepted for the following reasons:

- Entries received prior to the mail in date will be destroyed without notice.
- An illegible or incomplete entry, unsigned/altered/incorrect year on check, ineligible dogs.
- More than six (6) dog entries in one (1) envelope with different CPE ID numbers, per event.
- If the fees are not in US dollars.

An entry will be delayed or not delivered for the following reasons:

- Using any method other than Postal Mail or MyDogEntry
- The required signature on Express mail is NOT waived. UPS and FEDEX will not deliver to a PO Box.

Nationals CSS Information

Levels 3, 5, and C will be offered. There will be four (4) rotations and each level will run a certain element at that time. Each rotation will not start until all groups are completed.

The following classes will be offered, and the schedule will be as follows:

Odors that are allowed to be used:

Levels 3, 5, C: BIRCH (Betula Lenta)/ANISE (Pimpinella Anisum)/CLOVE (Eugenia caryophyllata).

Levels 5 and C: CYPRESS (Cupressus sempervirens) / Level C: VETIVER (Vetiveria zizanioides)

Trophies and Awards

Medals will be awarded for 1st through 4th place in each in each class.

Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to each dog earning a Qualifying score in any class.

There will be a High In Trial Award for each level offered. To be eligible, you must enter the highest level that you have earned Q's in for all runs. See below for eligibility requirements.

- To be eligible for the High In Trial Award, the dog must be entered in all runs at the same level.
- The dog must be entered in the highest level that they have earned a Q in. Exception is level C and entering level 5.
- If all classes are not at the same level, the dog may enter at a higher level only for Nationals and would then move back to the lower level after this event to complete any level requirements. All Q's will remain in the level in which they were earned.
- A dog can show in any level list above they just will not be eligible for the High In Trial award.

Other Show Information

ALL competitors are responsible for the information listed in the following.

- This event will be run under the CPE Rules and Regulations in effect at the time of the trial.
- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, competitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport.
- The competitors may carry treat bags or fanny packs for food rewards.

- Dogs must enter and exit the search area on leash. The leash may be any length including flexy/retractable leashes.
- Dogs may wear flat buckle collars, martingales, and/or harnesses and no hanging tags may be attached. **Exception:** A flat attached tag which is embedded into the collar.
- Dogs may wear a properly fitted harness constructed of either a nylon like material or leather. Dogs may wear both a collar and harness.
- The dogs may also wear any accessories deemed necessary by the handler including but not limited to jackets, sweaters, paw covers or booties, hair ties or bows. The Judge will determine if the accessory is safe and/or appropriate for the search.
- Handlers may carry their own personal timing device while on course.
- Off-leash searches may be allowed by the judge depending on the level. (Refer to the rulebook for off leash searches per level).
- Puppies under 8 weeks old are not allowed at a CPE trial. Selling of puppies at the show site is not allowed.
- Help keep the hotels for future trials! Clean up after the dogs. NO dogs are to be left in the room by themselves at any time! Bring sheets to cover sofas/chairs and bedspreads.

- Veterinarian and Hospital info will be included in future Nationals notifications and/or be available at the site.
- Competitors/handlers who are under 18 years old must be accompanied at the event by their parent or legal guardian, regardless of if they are signed up as a Jr Handler or not.

Team or State Shirts

The shirt can have "CPE," "Nationals" or "National Event," the dates of the event, city, and state.

Nationals Shirts

Shirts are ordered through Beauty Of The Beasts and can be picked up from their booth at Nationals or arrangements can be made with them to have them shipped to your home.

Show Site Information

- All Competitors are responsible for this information. Dogs MUST be on leash with the leash in the handler's hand (or picked up) at all times during the show each day from Tuesday set-up through Thursday's trophy presentation and tear down, when not in their crates/ex-pens/vehicle.
- **Note:** Exception is when dogs are in the warmup areas, or in your immediate camping area if camping, after the show each day and must be under direct handler supervision.
- Dogs must be on leash with it in the handler's hand (or dog picked up) before leaving the ring out-gate chutes.
- The Fairground buildings are smoke free. Smoking is NOT allowed in any building on the grounds. Smoking is permitted on the grounds, away from building entrances and at your RV.
- No campfires at any campsites.
- All exhibitors are expected to pick up after themselves and their dogs and deposit it in the provided trash barrels or you will be excused from the event. If a competitor is excused from the event, refunds will not be provided.
- It is expressly understood that competitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) and/or children. Any competitor whose dog(s) and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the show committee, be asked to leave the show site without a refund of fees.

Refund Policy

- There will be a \$25 administration fee per each dog's entry for refunds requested prior to the closing date.
- Once a request has been processed to pull a dog from Nationals, the request cannot be reversed regardless of the date or reason.
- Refund checks will be sent by August 14, 2026, for refunds received by the closing date, by late September for all other refunds.
- No refund for bitches in season after the closing date.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog or handler is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of CPE, the show committee, or a Judge.
- Entry fee will not be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Returned check fee of \$30 will be charged for all entries received for the member and will be on hold until restitution is made by a US funds Money Order, bank check or certified check. Restitution must be received within 7 days of notification from CPE, or all entries are cancelled for that member. If the entries are cancelled, the returned check fee of \$30 will still be outstanding; if not paid within the 7 days, the CPE membership will be inactivated until the fee is paid.
- Dogs that are injured after the closing date will be eligible for a refund of 50% of the entry fees upon receipt of a veterinarian's letter on their office letterhead. Notification by email by September 1, 2026, or at the site by September 15, 2026. Letters received after these dates will not be accepted and will not result in a refund.

- In the unfortunate circumstance of the death of a beloved dog who is entered in the trial: a full refund of that dog's entry fee will be issued, even if after the closing date. Notification by email or at the site by September 15, 2026.

Emergency Information: Veterinarian and Medical Center

- Will be available in show information emailed after closing and at the site during the trial.

The competitor must verify that the results were corrected as well.
