Trial Site & Information

The trial is being given in the agility building in the back of Dawn Phillips home, in a residential area of Selden NY. Complete directions will be provided in the final confirmation, sent a few days before the trial.

Participants will drive past the house, pool and barn and can park close to the agility building.

The agility building has limited seating and crating, so expect to work out of your car.

All dogs must be on leash at all times, except when in the ring. Exercise and toilet your dog in designated areas. Please poop and scoop and use garbage containers on the site. Please be courteous to others using the area. No aggressive dogs.

A warmup jump will be provided for all exhibitors.

Trial Site Rules

Please drive slowly all over the property. Human water can be taken from the white hose by the barn. Any hose can be used for dog water. Specific parking details to be in the confirmation.

Helpers and Food

We can't do it without volunteers!!!! Please come prepared to work classes you're not running in. Morning coffee, water and snacks will be available.

Bitches in Season -

May run at this trial. To be able to run a BIS, you must immediately tell the trial secretary, who will mark BIS on the running orders. The BIS will remain in their running order. If the dog is not wearing BIS pants, they will start on a mat provided by the show. It is the handler's responsibility to ensure the mat is available for their runs. The handler/owner acknowledges the inherent risk of running a dog on an agility course with BIS pants on and assumes all risk by doing so, and also the potential risks with slips from starting from a mat.

The BIS will be run as the last dog(s) per class.

Re: Combined Gamblers

This just means that there will be a single Gamblers Course for everyone, such that you all walk and run the same course. However, each level will be scored separately.

Terms and Conditions **You must read and agree to these terms before submitting your entry.**

By entering this event, you, as the entrant, acknowledge that you are authorized to act on behalf of both yourself and any other UK Agility International (UKI) members who will participate under your entry and you agree to the following:

1. Assumption of Risk & Liability

The exhibitor/owner certifies that any and all dogs brought to the facility, whether participating or not, do not pose a hazard to persons, dogs, or property. The exhibitor/owner assumes full responsibility, liability, and any resulting expenses for any damages caused by their dog(s). UK Agility International (UKI), UK Agility Ltd, their agents, officers, associates and members shall not be held liable for any loss, injury, damage, claims, demands, or liabilities involving your dog, yourself, or any third-party equipment. You agree to indemnify and hold harmless UKI and its representatives (including the club/group/ trial organizers, show management) from any claims, including legal fees, arising from injury or damages caused during participation in any event or training.

2. Hazards & Safety

The exhibitor/owner acknowledges all potential hazards associated with the training facility, event, and premises, including but not limited to: The condition of the grounds; Lighting and security measures (or lack thereof); Electrical appliances and fittings; Parking areas and fencing; The potential for a dog to escape from the training or competition area; The presence of unfamiliar animals and people; The presence of other dogs; Agility equipment; Course design and course set up; The possibility of another ill animal or your own getting ill. The exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from and all of these including allowing their dogs to run wearing collars, stop pad protectors, bitch in season pants, or any similar items.

By entering, you voluntarily assume any and all risks associated with these hazards and any other potential hazards not listed. All participants must exercise caution, monitor their dogs, and clean up after themselves and their animals.

3. Conduct & Enforcement

UK Agility International reserves the right to:

- **Excuse any participant** for what it deems excessive harshness toward a dog and for behavior considered aggressive or abusive toward another person or dog.
- **Revoke, suspend, or ban** any entry or membership at its sole discretion if deemed necessary to protect the interests of UK Agility and any of its associates, agents, officers, or members.

Participation in UKI events, including membership, is a **privilege, not a right**. UK Agility International has full authority to impose suspensions or bans without prior notice.

4. Rules & Regulations

By entering, you agree to comply with all UK Agility International Rules & Regulations, including any amendments. Additionally, you confirm that:

You will not bring any dog that has been knowingly exposed to an infectious or contagious disease within 21 days prior to the event.

- To the best of your knowledge, your dog is not subject to disqualification under UK Agility International Show Regulations.
- You accept full responsibility for you and your dogs' own safety and participation.

Measuring Dogs

Please ensure you understand the criteria regarding dogs being measured. Refer to the current edition rule book which can be found on the UKI web page. [UKI 11th Edition Rule Book.pdf](#) A summary of the rules can also be found here [Jump Heights | UK Agility International](#)

If a dog is under 3 and newly registered, a temporary measure or proof of the dog's height must be done by the dog's 3rd trial. A permanent measure must be obtained by a UKI official measurer between 12-18 months after the dog's first/ temporary measure. Any registered dog that only has a temporary measure, must follow the above rule. If a newly registered dog is over 3, they must obtain a measure by an official UKI measurer by their 3rd trial and this measurement will be permanent.

Level Move-ups Exhibitors are responsible for tracking their dog's points in each of the two UKI programs and must move their dog to the next eligible level on the following day of a multiple-day trial once sufficient points have been earned. Competitors must notify the trial secretary on the day their dog gains enough points to move up in a particular program. Exhibitors may log into their UKI account to confirm and tally points. Please consult the UKI rule book for detailed information on level requirements.

BY ENTERING UKI EVENTS, COMPETITORS AGREE TO the following and the terms and conditions on the entry forms

UK Agility International Rules and Regulations apply to the whole event, and all people and dogs must comply with these at all times. As a competitor it is your responsibility to be aware of the rules and regulations as they stand at the time of the show. This show will run under the current edition UK Agility International rules found on the UKI web page.

Competitors through submission of entry acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of UK Agility International rules and regulations including but not limited to the following rules regarding entry

Please ensure to read the move up rules – section 2.0. At a UKI trial where the dog is competing for more than one day and the dog completes the requirements for a level on a prior day; they must move up the following day.

All dogs and handlers must be registered with UK Agility International to compete. UK Agility International's official rules & regulations are available to view free from the UKI web page. If you or your dog is not already registered, please register online at www.ukagilityinternational.com

All dogs are entered at this show at their owners' risk; and neither the show nor event management nor UKI will accept responsibility for any loss, damage or injury, however caused or claimed to have been caused by or to dogs, persons or property while at the UKI event.

A dog shall be withdrawn from competition without refund if it is: suffering from any infectious or contagious disease, interfering with the safety of any person or other animal or if it is likely to cause itself damage or its welfare is in danger if it continues competing.

It is expressly understood that competitors are solely responsible for the behavior of their dogs, children and guests. Any competitor whose dogs, children, or guests create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, will at the discretion of the show management, be asked to remove the offending dogs, children, guests from the event grounds. Any competitor or competitor's dog that is dismissed from the show by the judge and or show manager in accordance with UKI rules and regulations will have no recourse of any kind including, but not limited, to any refund of fees paid such as entry fees, camping fees, crating fees and any other fees associated with the event.

Rules of Conduct

UKI promotes dog agility pursuant to regulations consistent with international standards as a competitive, spectator sport. All competitors, officials, and event personnel shall conduct themselves in a professional and sportsmanlike manner consistent with the foregoing statement of purpose and seek to uphold, and enhance where possible, the image of the sport and UKI through such conduct and actions including on social media platforms.

By virtue of your entry, competitors acknowledge and agree to comply with all UKI rules and regulations and agree to accept any sanctions that are imposed for failure to comply. The judge has responsibility for determining when it is appropriate to excuse a dog and competitor from the ring. The show officials have responsibility for determining when an infraction should result in a verbal warning, written warning and/or expulsion of a competitor, dog, or any person from the event by conducting the procedure outlined in the UKI rule book. UKI officials, after further investigation, may impose sanctions including suspension or expulsion from future events.

The following is a partial list of infractions on which the judge or trial officials will take action: Abuse of a dog on the grounds; actions that may have the appearance of abuse of a dog; willful misconduct or interference with a competitor's right to show; any acts of poor sportsmanship; violation of procedural rules; compulsive, correctional training on the grounds; willful misrepresentation on entry forms; willful misrepresentation of animals; dog aggression; failure to exercise diligence in the control of the behavior of their dog including a dog clearly not under the control of the handler; concerns for the welfare of a dog or who is unfit for competing; intimidation and/or impolite confrontation of judges, event officials, event helpers, or other competitors; creating excessive delays as a failure to respect the authority of event officials.

Social Media Conduct

Cyber bullying of any kind towards UKI, trial management & staff, competitors, judges, helpers or volunteers will not be tolerated. Examples of cyber bullying include but are not limited to, communications that seek to intimidate, manipulate, falsely discredit, put down, try to control, rudely confront, demand, and comments that try to incite further issues. Further, UKI is committed to maintaining an environment that is built on mutual respect and is free from racism, discrimination and harassment. In keeping with this goal, any behavior that is hateful towards race, color, religion, creed, national origin or ancestry, ethnicity, sex, and gender will not be tolerated. Any of these cases may warrant removal from all associated social media pages and even lead to expulsion of UKI events and even further expulsion of organization membership.

Refund and Entry Cancellation Policy

Entries will not be accepted, changed, or altered after the closing date or capping level has been reached except for the purpose of moving to a higher level. A full refund is available for any membership that is not older than 14 days from the date of account creation. A full refund is available before the closing date or capping level is met for any show. There will be no cost if refund money is to be left in your UKI account. If a refund is requested, a 5% administration fee for a credit card refund will be assessed, per transaction. After the closing date, a partial entry may be available for extraordinary circumstances, but this lies with the individual show management based on their own policies. Contact the show management for details, NOT UKI.

Additional administration charges may be imposed to a member's account due to negligence that result in administration time to correct. Possible infractions, not limited to, are submitting incorrect trial entry information, including incorrect handler and dog number, creating duplicate membership or dog accounts and late payment fees.

Media & Sponsor Rights Release

Through the entry into this event, all competitors grant to UKI and its affiliated companies, representatives, agents and assigns, all rights and permission to use or appropriate his/her and their dog's name, biography, likeness, photograph, voice, performing persona, or other indicia of identity for broadcast, telecast, cablecast, transmission or distribution in any format or media known now or in the future. Further, I hereby release UKI and its affiliates, representatives, agents and assigns from any claim or cause of action for invasion of the rights of privacy, right of publicity, right of personality, or any similar right. Sponsors of UKI events may email entrants with their product and or service information. If a competitor does not wish to receive emails from these sponsors, they must email the show management before the close of the trial entry date to declare this, ensuring they receive a receipt email that this information has been received by the trial management.

More information from PMCC / Dogs Gone Wild

There is a new process for measuring. You can no longer show an AKC Permanent Height card in lieu of being measured. If your online account doesn't show an asterisk * next to your dog's name, you need to be measured.

You can still show an AKC Measurement to count as a temporary measurement. More in the final confirmation

Timing equipment is owned by PMCC. All UKI-LI ribbons are provided by PMCC Services.

-Flat Ribbons are awarded for all qualifying runs. Data information labels should be available.

Q stickers may be available from the trial secretary.

-Larger ribbons for big accomplishments like IAC, IWAC, CSS, WCSS will be available, plus New Title.

-The new pmccservices.com website lists upcoming trials. Premiums, 1-TDC and Merch are available there!

Since games Qs are required for most every level title, we are offering Gamblers class each day.

-You are expected to pay for your entries by Oct 6 unless specific arrangements are made. Once the show closes online, you can no longer pay online.
