Telephone, email and fax entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms or Entry forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the form are not acceptable. Unsigned Entry Forms cannot be accepted nor entries which specify any conditions as to its acceptance. Entry Forms **MUST** be filled out completely. Incomplete entries do not constitute a valid entry.

Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, & no entry will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after published closing date. **PLEASE PRINT OR TYPE CLEARLY. NO STAPLES OR TAPE PLEASE.**

Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a **\$25** collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

Exhibitors will receive an email **confirmation** of their entries being received. Exhibitors will also receive an email confirmation of their inclusion on the Wait List. After the entry period closes, the Trial Secretary will send a final confirmation with classes entered.

Class Transfers and Move Ups – The Trial Secretary will accept requests for move-ups or other class transfers after entries have closed for these trials. Prior to the opening date, create an account for your dog(s) that includes their AKC information and your email address, phone number and other information.

When the trials open, you are ready to enter.

If limits are not met, we will accept Day-of-Event Entries. The entry form **MUST** be provided to the Trial Secretary by 8:00 A.M. for the date entered.

A wait list will be offered to fill openings created by entries that are withdrawn after the trial closes or the registration limit is reached. Entries received after the registration limit is reached will automatically be added to the Waiting List until that limit is reached as of 9:00 PM on the day on which they were received until that limit is reached. We will maintain a waitlist of 20 entries.

Wait list refunds – if a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, the withdrawn entry will be entitled to a full refund. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial will be entitled to a full refund. Withdrawn entries that are not replaced by a wait listed entry will not receive a refund.

At the trial if a dog earns its title (3rd leg) in trial 1, notify the judge they will be moving up and complete a "move up form" immediately for the Trial Secretary. The Trial Secretary will have forms available on site for transfer requests. If moving from Advanced to Excellent the increased class fee will be applied.

A/B SECTIONS

The Novice A class is for beginners. Dogs who have earned a title in an element from the AKC or from another organization and those handlers who have worked as professional detection dog handlers must enter the B section. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/divisions. Failure to do so will result in the cancellation of qualifying scores.

CLASS INFORMATION

Levels – Dogs that have previously earned the same or higher level AKC Scent Work titles may enter lower-level classes. Dogs may enter up to two (2) difficulty levels for which they are eligible in each element, in each trial.

Run Order – The Run Order will be determined after entries have closed and will be sent by email to entrants who have provided a legible email address. *We reserve the right to make changes if conditions warrant or to load balance.*

The Class Order will be Novice T1, T2; Advanced T1, T2; Excellent T1, T2; Master T1, T2. Trial 1 and 2 will run concurrently. **Note: You do NOT have to run T1 & T2 back-to-back;** alert the Gate Steward before the class begins and tell the judge when you begin your runs. If not sure, see the trial chair or a committee person.

WARM UP AREA

A warm-up area will be available consisting of one labeled container per target odor being used in the trial on that day. Exhibitors should limit their warm-up to two minutes or less. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the handler-dog teams prior their run. The warm-up area is not for training and you **should NOT potty your dog near the area.**

HANDLER DISCRIMINATION DIVISON

Handler Discrimination classes are titling classes in which the targeted scent is that of the handler themselves. Handlers are required to provide their own scented articles in a plastic bag, for the Novice class, one cotton glove or cotton sock, for Advanced, Excellent, and Master, cotton balls or cotton swabs. Three qualifying scores are required to earn titles in each class.

DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs SIX (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete.

Condition of Dogs . Dogs with physical challenges (including amputees) are eligible to participate provided that, in the opinion of the judge, they display no signs of physical discomfort and can safely complete the search. Dogs with bandages, sutures, or visible wounds are not eligible. Deaf dogs and blind dogs are allowed to enter. Dogs that are both deaf and blind are able to participate so long as the handler is in control of the dog at all times, the dog can complete the requirements of the class, and the dog does not appear to be under undue stress in the opinion of the judge.

RIBBONS, AWARDS AND PRIZES

Flat ribbons will be awarded:

Third..... *Yellow*
Fourth *White*
Qualifying *Dark Green*

A new title rosette or medal will be awarded to all teams finishing a title
Elite title ribbons or medal will be available

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

The Sailfish Agility Capital of Florida Agility Club, the trial secretary, their agents, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors or their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children not under the control of their parents or guardians.

RIGHT TO REFUSE: The Sailfish Agility Capital of Florida Agility Club, as the club holding this event has the right to refuse any entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient.

ALL DOGS MUST BE CRATED while waiting to run. Crating space will be available indoors in air conditioning in the designated area on a tarp. Crates may be left overnight; however, the Sailfish Capital Agility Club will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the trial site.

No dogs may be left overnight on the grounds of the trial site.

Barking Dogs - Any exhibitor with a dog barking excessively will be asked to crate the dog from their vehicle. If refused, the exhibitor will be asked to leave the trial and forfeit their fees.

Exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs. Any exhibitor whose dog(s) create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site, with no refund of any fees.

IF IT IS NECESSARY TO RESCUE A DOG from a parked car on the show grounds, the Club will not be responsible or liable for any damage to the car involved.

Owners or handlers entering dogs in a trial do so at their own risk and agree to assume responsibility for any damage caused by them, or by their dogs. They also agree to abide by the Rules of the American Kennel Club and the current edition of the AKC Agility Regulations.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

Anyone in violation of a restriction pursuant to AKC rules or policies, or the law can be asked to leave the grounds. If the person fails to leave, the local authorities will be contacted. In addition, if the club believes laws, restrictions, or conditions of release are being violated by an individual's attendance or participation in AKC events, the local authorities will be contacted immediately as they have the authority of enforcement.

Spectator Area will be available at this trial. No one outside the search area may assist the handler or disclose the location of the hide. Spectators who intentionally or unintentionally give aid to a team may be asked to leave the area by the judge. Spectators are forbidden to discuss details of the search with handlers who have not run.

Exhibitors are responsible for **cleaning up after their dog(s)**. Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

ANY dog that soils on the **artificial turf** will be charged a \$20 cleaning fee. The crating area will be marked off and will have tarps in an attempt to avoid accidents. Some classes will run on the artificial turf; Any dog that soils urinates on an item during their run, the exhibitor will be charged the cleaning or replacement costs.

Please potty dogs away from the building and do not let dogs go to the bathroom on the landscaping. Additionally – refer to the map for walking and relieving your dog. Part of the grounds will be used for Exterior runs.

Alcohol policy: The consumption of alcohol during event hours is prohibited. Anyone found in violation of this policy will be asked to leave the premises.

Bratty Paws Dog Plex is a **SMOKE FREE PROPERTY**.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER TRIALS

This trial is open to all dogs six (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing

Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word “dog” is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Puppies under four (4) months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. **No refunds for overpayments \$10 or less.**

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete. As such, the club will refund entry fees minus \$5 processing fee per day for bitches unable to compete for this reason upon presentation of a veterinarian certificate. This certificate must be presented to the Trial Secretary no later than 30 minutes prior to the start of judging on the first day of the trial.
