Entries will be limited to 125 dogs per event, two events daily running concurrently 8:00AM-6:00PM. First time Block of 8-9AM will be for workers and club members. Field will open at 7:30AM.

Your time block will be sent in the final confirmation. You can request morning of afternoon times and running with friends, please not that on the entry form.

Awards will be available in batches at the end of each running block at the check-in table.

DOS entries **will only be accepted after 1:30 p.m.** and that pre-registered dogs will be given priority for both of their runs before DOS are run. If it is after 1:30 and there are no pre-entered dogs in line, DACLI may allow DOS entries to run.

Fun runs will be accepted for a fee of \$20. Fun runs will not be run until the conclusion of the show. Fun run entries will not be accepted until 2 p.m. People will not be allowed to stand in line until that time if there are still dogs running. Having additional people and dogs in the area add difficulty to checking in and examining dogs entered in the show. The block will only remain open until 3 p.m. It will be up to the club and lure operators to decide if the time may be extended due to demand. There are no ribbons or records of time for fun runs.

DACLI and the Lure Operator will take an hour break mid-day. No entries will be taken during that time. The break will be at or near noon. The exact time may vary based upon weather and other variables. Additional breaks may be needed to fix the line, should the weather be inclement or for any unexpected conditions. Every effort will be made to keep those breaks to a minimum.

The inspection committee has the authority to disallow a dog's entry into a test and, in such instances, applicable entry fees will be refunded. At roll call, all dogs will be measured by a wicket to verify handicaps. Bitches in season, lame and unfit dogs will be excused with entry refunded. Please do not bring bitches in season to the test.

Run times will be assigned and sent out prior to the trial. On completion of your runs, please leave the property to help maintain an appropriate population size.

Dogs must have an AKC registration number and be at least one year of age on the day of the trial. Dogs may only run once per test. One dog per entry form. All entries must be accompanied with a check to be valid. A returned check is not

a valid entry. There will be a \$35 fee for a returned check. Entries received by phone, text, or email will not be accepted. Incomplete entries or forms without signature will not be accepted.

Fast CAT events are open to all dogs at least 12 months of age that are individually registered with the AKC, recorded in the Foundation Stock Service (FSS) program, individually registered with a foreign or

domestic registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration, dogs granted a Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) number, dogs with AKC Limited or Conditional Registration, or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program. Dogs with breed disqualifications and monorchid/cryptorchid dogs are eligible to participate. At roll call, all dogs will be examined for disqualification. Bitches known to be in season are not to be brought to the test. At inspection, bitches in season, lame and unfit dogs will be excused with entry refunded.

Hours

Grounds will be available by 8:00 AM each day. **A briefing will be emailed with the running order. Roll Call will occur as you line up for your runs.**

Trial will begin promptly at 8:00am with a block of worker & club member dogs.

Exhibitor check-in will begin at 8:00am, and the first exhibitor running block will begin at 9:00am, until all runs are completed. 16 dogs will be scheduled to run each hour and concurrent trials will be in effect. **Once your two runs are completed you MUST leave the grounds.**

It is the responsibility of each entrant to make an effort to be ready when their dog is called to the line. Exhibitors must bring two leashes, one to release their dog and one for the catcher of their dog.

Prizes

DACLI will offer a light blue flat ribbon for a passing qualifying run. **DACLI will have a limited number of title rosettes available. Please notify the trial secretary with your entry form if you will be earning the following titles to ensure that the club will have rosettes available:**

BCAT ----- 150 points

DCAT ----- 500 points

FCAT --- 1,000 points

FCAT2 - 1,500 points

What is the Fast CAT?

Fast CAT is a timed straight 100-yard dash for dogs. Dogs are held at the start line and the coursing lure is activated, prompting the dog to follow chasing it to the finish line and into a catch pen. The course is completely fenced, and dogs are run individually. Dogs are timed when they complete the 100-yard dash. The time is converted to Miles Per Hour (MPH).

FORMULA: $204.545 / \text{RUN TIME} = \text{MPH}$

$\text{MPH} \times \text{HANDICAP} = \text{POINTS (ROUNDED TO NEAREST 0.01)}$

Based on the dog's size at the withers a handicap is applied, and points are earned:

- 18" or greater = Handicap is 1.0
- 12" up to less than 18" = Handicap is 1.5.
- Below 12" = Handicap is 2.0.

MPH X HANDICAP = POINTS

Titles are earned at specific point levels and the highest suffix may appear after the dog's name:

BCAT = 150 points

DCAT = 500 points

FCAT = 1,000 points

FCAT# = Each additional 500 points

Trial Site Directions

From Points West:

Take I-495 E/Long Island Expy to exit 67 for County Rd 21/Yaphank Ave toward Yaphank/Brookhaven. Fork right onto County Rd 21/Yaphank Ave S. Turn right at the sign for the Suffolk County Farm & Education Center.

From the Bridgeport-Port Jeff. Ferry (Connecticut to Long Island):

Turn right onto W Broadway. Turn left onto Barnum Ave.
Turn right onto NY-25A E/Main St. Continue onto NY-112 N/Patchogue Rd. In 4 miles, turn right onto Patchogue-Mount Sinai Rd. Continue straight to stay on Patchogue-Mount Sinai Rd onto North Ocean Ave. Turn left onto Express Dr S. Use the left lane to merge onto I-495 E via the ramp to Riverhead. Follow Directions from Points West.

Notice To All Exhibitors

All exhibitors must be responsible for cleaning up after their dogs on the motel and trial grounds. Motels require that dogs be crated when unattended. Any damages to motels or the trial site can result in disciplinary action by the Event Committee. It is expected that exhibitors will clean up immediately after their own dogs and strongly encourage others to do the same. All owners/exhibitors should be aware that the entire motel grounds are considered within the trial grounds. You will be responsible for all damage to your room/site and may be subject to disciplinary action in accordance with the rules of the AKC. Any abuse of the grounds will be brought to the attention of the trial-giving club and its Event Committee.

DACLI Trial Information

- Dogs should be warmed up before and cooled down after running.
- **ALL DOGS RUN AT OWNER'S SOLE RISK**
- All entries must be 12 months of age or older on the day of the test.
- All AKC rules regarding sportsmanship and conduct apply.
- This is a rain-or-shine outdoor event. Please plan accordingly. Please bring your own shade, chairs and water.
- An electronic timing system will be used. An electric, continuous loop, plastic strip lure machine will be used.

- The show grounds are not completely fenced. The FAST CAT course will be fenced.
- On site bathrooms are available. No dogs are permitted in the bathroom
- Dogs must be on lead or crated unless running.
- **A \$5 fine will be assessed for any loose dog on the field not competing, or an exhibitor caught not picking up after their dog.**
- You are responsible for controlling your dog(s) and children.
- Each dog requires an individual entry form for the runs it is entered in
- Bitches in season and lame dogs will be excused. **Entry fees will be refunded.**
- The Huntmaster is responsible for field safety and therefore she is in complete charge of all dogs and handlers on the field. In service to this responsibility, she has the authority to stop the lure in any potentially dangerous situation and signal the handler to retrieve the dog on the course.
- Persons exhibiting conduct detrimental to the AKC/SCKC/any dog(s)/other person(s) will be asked to leave the trial site by the Field Committee, maybe disciplined by the AKC, and **entry fees will not be refunded.**
- **No entry fees will be refunded** if the event cannot be started or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club.
- The event-hosting club, Dog Agility Club of Long Island, its agents, members, representatives, volunteers, etc., assume no liability or responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children or spectators before, during, or after this event.
- All City and State Regulations in effect during these events will be enforced. While COVID restrictions have been lifted at this time, circumstances may change. This is notice that any change to restrictions will apply at the time of the event.

LONG ISLAND FAST CAT TRIFECTA AWARD

MASCUSA, DACLI and SCKC will sponsor a special award for the 3 Long Island Fast CAT weekends in November.

The Long Island Fast Cat Trifecta Rosette will be given to the dog with the fastest average time in each height division. In order to qualify, the dog must compete in all 12 trials (2 per day x 6 days) over the 3 weekends in November 2026.

You must sign up at the MASCUSA trial to be eligible. There will be a form to fill out. If you miss any of the subsequent trials/runs, you(r dog) will no longer remain eligible. After the final trial, the total accumulated times will be calculated and the Rosette will be awarded to the dog and handler with the lowest average time for all 12 runs in that division.

Proposed ribbon designs- all 3 heights will be the same ribbon.

Minimum: 8" rosette head and 5- 36" streamers
