NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- The safety of the dogs is the primary concern so by entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog(s) and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. If an exhibitor is asked to leave the trial site, then the exhibitor will not be refunded any fees that have been paid.
- Entry fees will not be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on the entry forms. Any illegible or incomplete entries will not be entered in the trial.
- Fee for returned checks is \$25.00
- Refunds requested after the closing date will be given only for a dog that suffers an injury and/or illness or bitches that come into season. Requests for said refunds must be received in writing prior to the start of the event. Please include documentation from your veterinarian verifying the condition, illness or injury. A \$5.00 processing fee, per run entered, will be assessed for all requested refunds.
